

List of Supplies Needed

If you can help us out with supplies, it helps us prepare. For each item listed, we have noted the date we will be using them and it would be helpful to have the supplies 1 or 2 weeks prior to that date. If you are not able to provide these items, no problem. It is likely we will get plenty of extras!

- 1) June 4 would like to have these by May 24.
 - a. Semi-rigid clear water or pop bottle. For example, a Dasani bottle. Remove label and clean.
 - b. Clean wooden spoons.
- 2) June 11 would like these by May 31
 - a. Flexible clear plastic water of pop bottle. Like the less expensive water bottles. Remove label and clean.
 - b. Old CD or DVD.
- 3) June 18 would like these by June 7
 - a. Old jigsaw puzzle. Best if there are large swaths of color, like a big red barn, or a large black cat. No more than one per family.
 - b. Colorful magazine. No more than one per family.
- 4) June 25 would like these by June 14
 - a. A stick (from a tree). About 14 16 inches long and ½ inch wide. One per child. This is a good task to assign to the kids!
- 5) June 25 kids should bring these in on June 25
 - a. Lightly used toys. We will be doing a toy swap.
